## International Contestants

### Customs Clearance

Your options to temporarily import your boat for this event are as follows:

- ATA Carnet, OR
- Customs Security – can only be used where the **Duty & GST liability is less than AUD\$50,000**. This is where you can temporarily import your boat for this event into Australia and not have to put up a security to the Australian Government. Boat must be exported within 6 months of importation.
- Customs Paper Security – Will be used where you **do not have a valid Carnet or the total Duty & GST liability of your consignment exceeds AUD\$50,000**. You will need to put up a monetary security for your boat. Upon exportation of the boat within 6 months, Customs will release their hold on these funds.

### Quarantine Clearance

#### If importing by Air

- Your boat will be inspected by a Quarantine Officer upon arrival

#### If importing by Sea

- We will need to unpack the container for a Quarantine Officer to inspect your boat. The goods are subject to inspection to determine that they are clean and free from visible clumps of algae and completely dry.

## Brown Marmorated Stink Bug

If your boat is coming from any of the below countries by seafreight, it will need to be treated offshore for Brown Marmorated Stink bug BEFORE being shipped to Australia. Failing this, your container can be treated upon arrival into Australia, this will however slow down clearance through Quarantine while your cargo is being treated.

**Airfreight: If you send these boats by airfreight they are not captured by the Brown Marmorated Stink Bug season as cargo arriving by airfreight are exempt from treatment for this pest. So sending by airfreight will greatly reduce treatment costs and potential delays caused by onshore treatment / inspections in Australia.**

## How long should you allow for Customs and Quarantine Clearance in Australia?

- Seafreight – Allow upto 2 weeks
- Airfreight – Allow upto 1 week
